The Scouting for Food program is a national Scout event aimed at collecting food for the needy. Participating Scouts will distribute a limited number of empty bags and grocery lists to houses throughout Burlington on the first weekend. On the following weekend, the Scouts will collect the bags filled with groceries. We will then donate the collected food to the Burlington Food Pantry.

**BAG/LIST PICK UP**

WHEN: Saturday, November 8th, 10-11am (RSVP required)

WHERE: Francis Wyman School Parking Lot

Scouts must RSVP first to Becky Icken at [beckyicken@comcast.net](mailto:beckyicken@comcast.net). Scouts should come to Francis Wyman that morning to pick up their bags and select a street. Scouts should then distribute the bags that day. Note: the Scouts are not expected to knock on doors or solicit people directly. Instead, the Scouts will leave the empty bags on door-steps.

**GROCERY COLLECTION AND RETURN**

WHEN: Saturday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 10am-Noon

WHERE: Burlington Food Pantry

Parents should help the Scouts retrieve the Groceries (that families will leave outside their doors Saturday morning). Parents should then bring the bags directly to the Burlington Food Pantry.

WHEN: Saturday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 10am-Noon

WHERE: Burlington Food Pantry
